Registering during this time period is very helpful for festival planning. Even if you are unable to attend the Feast this year, we request that you register and indicate such.

### IN ADDITION, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT ALL MEMBERS KNOW

- If you already registered for the Feast, you should have received a confirmation email in return. If you did not receive a confirmation email, please re-register and make sure it is completed correctly.
- The Feast sites in Rapid City, South Dakota, and Cortona, Italy, are filled to capacity, and are closed to further transfers.
- If you are still deciding where to attend, we would like to make you are aware of the site on the west coast that still has plenty of room:
  - **San Diego, California** – located in the beautiful coastal city in Southern California. This year we are again at the refurbished Crown Plaza Hotel.

Thank you very much for taking the time to register and letting us know what your plans are. Again, we encourage everyone to complete the registration process by Monday, May 7.

Early housing reservations also begin on Monday, May 7. Beginning on Monday, May 14, general housing reservations will be accepted. In addition, everyone who registers for the Feast will receive an email offering an opportunity to serve.

### EARLY HOUSING Announcement:

Those who qualify to make early housing reservations can begin doing so on Monday, May 7. Members who qualify to make early reservations include:

1. Those who need handicapped rooms.
2. Those with very limited finances who need to be assured of procuring one of the lower-priced rooms.
3. Those who, due to dietary requirements, must have a kitchenette.
4. Those who have a large immediate family (six or more).

## Job Opening – Video Production

The Media department of the Church of God, a Worldwide Association, has an immediate opening in video production. Basic job responsibilities and/or requirements include:

- Editing various video projects, including video, music and sound effects.
- Shooting video of various presentations for staff, the membership, the general public, the Internet and television.
- Designing lighting and set pieces for various projects.
- Functioning as a technical director during studio recordings.
- Designing concepts and graphics.
- Occasionally writing/editing copy.

Ideally, we prefer to have someone with a bachelor's degree in video production from a four-year college or university and at least three years' related experience in video editing, camera operation, television production, graphics design, sound design, music editing, etc. However, we would not rule out considering an equivalent combination of education and experience, and we are willing to consider someone who has a level of experience but might need further training. Employment start date is negotiable.

You must be a baptized member in good standing of the Church of God, a Worldwide Association, unless approved by the president, and possess a working knowledge of the doctrines, beliefs and practices of the Church of God, a Worldwide Association. And you must be willing and able to relocate to the Church headquarters area in Texas.

## MARRIAGE SEMINAR

The Clarksville, Maryland congregation will be hosting a three-day marriage seminar titled “The Seven C’s” given by Mr. Arnold Hampton, Pastor and Regional Director of the Caribbean and member of the Ministerial Board of Directors. The seminar will begin late Friday afternoon, August 3<sup>rd</sup> and end Sunday at 12 noon, August 5<sup>th</sup>. The Seven C’s of the seminar are Completion, Companionship, Communication, Closeness, Creation, Correlation, and Covenant of Commitment.

In addition to an Introduction to the Seven C’s, there will be a session on Financial Planning and a separate Breakout Session for men and women for a total of 9 sessions. Certificates will be given at the end of the seminar. The cost of the seminar is \$100 per person, \$200 per couple which covers Class Materials, Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner and Snacks during the 3-day seminar.

The seminar will be held at the Sheraton Columbia Town Center Hotel. A limited number of discount hotel accommodations at the Sheraton Columbia Town Center Hotel are \$246 (includes tax) for 2 nights. Sabbath services on August 4<sup>th</sup> will be held at the same location.
