MORGANTOWN MEETING WITH PITTSBURGH ON MARCH 9TH

From Mr. Don Henson: We'll be meeting at the Chartiers Township Community Center, 2013 Community Center Dr, Houston PA 15342. The hall is near Exit #41 (Race Track Rd) from Interstate 79. Take the exit and go west on Race Track (in the opposite direction of the casinos); at the first signal turn right (north) onto Pike St. The hall is just past the Chartiers Junior/Senior High School; turn left onto Silver Maples St; the hall is about 200 yards ahead on the right.

For the last few years Morgantown has joined Pittsburgh & Wheeling for an annual "Almost Spring" social, this year on March 9. The schedule begins at 12:00pm with a Teen Speech Club meeting. The Sabbath service will be at 3:00pm – a little later than usual to accommodate the rest of the schedule for the day. A potluck dinner will be served at about 5:15pm or so.
