Announcement regarding holy day offerings for fall holy days:

The COVID-19 pandemic has affected just about every aspect of our lives, including how the Church has collected and processed the annual holy day offerings. We prefer, of course, to collect a congregational offering as we have always done in past years, but unfortunately, this is an unusual time.

For safety reasons, and because of regulations in a number of locations, it is our plan to handle the holy day offerings for the fall festivals (Feast of Trumpets, Atonement, the Feast of Tabernacles and Last Great Day) as we did those for the first three holy days this year—except that we will also have a box on the information table on the holy days for members who wish to give their offering at services.

We will have an offertory message as usual, but we will not physically collect the holy day offering as we have in prior years. We ask that you give your offering by one of the following options:

Access to COGWA Feast webcasts:

COGWA will be hosting live, daily webcasts from 10 of our U.S. Feast sites this year: Branson, Missouri; Cincinnati, Ohio/Northern Kentucky; Fort Myers, Florida; Kerrville, Texas; Lancaster, Pennsylvania; Myrtle Beach, South Carolina; Orange Beach, Alabama; Park City, Utah; Post Falls, Idaho; and Tucson, Arizona.

Access to all of these webcasts (in English) will be available on the cogwa.tv website, on Roku and through the Feast of Tabernacles smartphone app. Spanish webcasts will be available on iddam.org/webcast and on Roku.

Please note: A password will be required on the cogwa.tv website. The password is **foT** (just those three letters).

Please note: All of our morning services will begin at 10 a.m. in the time zone in which they originate (see the table below).

Options if webcast goes down: If you experience technical issues, or if your local webcast stops, you'll have other options:

1. You can access one of the other Feast webcasts *in your time zone*.
2. You can access the replay option available for Myrtle Beach. (Note: Myrtle Beach is the only site that will offer a replay option throughout the Feast.)
3. You can wait for a webcast from a Feast site in a time zone *west* of you. (This would not be an option for those in the Pacific time zone.)
